Biography

Christian Coomer serves as the Representative for Georgia's 14th State House District, which is comprised of portions of Bartow and Floyd Counties. He was first elected in 2010 and sworn in on January 10, 2011. Rep. Coomer currently serves as the Chairman of the Transportation Committee, and is a member of the following committees: Appropriations, Public Safety Subcommittee; Banks and Banking; Judiciary Non-Civil; Juvenile Justice; and Retirement. In addition, he is appointed to the Public Defender Standards Legislative Oversight Committee, the Fiscal Affairs Oversight Joint Subcommittee, and serves as the chairman of Bartow County Legislative Delegation.

Rep. Coomer earned his Bachelor of Arts degree in Communication, *Magna Cum Laude*, from Lee University in Cleveland, Tennessee and earned his Juris Doctor degree at the University of Georgia Lumpkin School of Law in Athens. Rep. Coomer served four years on active duty in the United States Air Force Judge Advocate General (JAG) Corps before opening his own law practice in Cartersville. He still serves as JAG in the Georgia Air National Guard. In his law practice, Christian represents clients in criminal and civil litigation, estate planning, adoptions, and appellate practice.

Locally, Christian has served as a member of the boards for several non-profit organizations including the Good Neighbor Homeless Shelter, Adairsville Church of God, and North Bartow Toys for Tots. In addition, he is or has been a member of the Chamber of Commerce, Optimists, Civitans, Exchange Club, Bartow County Bar Association, National Rifle Association, Georgia Carry, Advance Adairsville, Georgia Right to Life, Company Grade Officers Association, Fellowship of Christian Athletes, Bartow County Republican Party, and others. He also serves on the Board of Directors for the Church of God Benefits Board, which manages nearly a half billion dollars in retirement assets for clergy members.

Christian met his wife Heidi at Lee University, where she earned her degree in Music. They have two sons, Christian, 13, and Collin, 9.
