Biography

Born and raised in Marietta, GA, Rep. Dollar is a graduate of Pope High School. He was a HOPE scholar at the University of Georgia, graduating cum laude with a degree in Political Science and was also a graduate of the University's prestigious Honor's Program. While a student at UGA, Matt worked two Sessions at the Georgia Capitol as well as being the recipient an Honor's Fellowship to work in DC for the Dept. of Energy.

Dollar was first elected as a member of the Georgia General Assembly in 2002. He represents House District 45, which includes East Cobb County and Sandy Springs.

In the Legislature, he serves on the important Appropriations committee, as well as the Energy, Utilities, & Telecommunications, Reapportionment, and Insurance committees. He is also the Chairman of the Interstate Cooperation Committee, being the youngest member in the Georgia Legislature's history to be named Chairman.

Along with his Georgia legislative duties, Dollar is also active in national organizations such as National Council of State Legislators (NCSL) and American Legislative Exchange Council (ALEC), serving on committees and task forces for both organizations. In 2009 he was nominated to the American Council of Young Political Leaders, and is an active alumnus of that organization.
