She has also served as a county commissioner for Hancock County from 1995-1996.

Since 2001, she has served as the Director of the Sparta-Hancock County Development Authority and has had active involvement with First American Home Care for over 25 years. She is also an active member of Economic Development & Tourism and Public Utilities & Telecommunications Committees.
