Representative Jimmy Pruett is a state legislator serving House District 144, which includes the counties of Dodge, Bleckley and Wilcox, as well as portions of Ben Hill and Pulaski counties. Rep. Pruett is a former Administration Floor Leader to Governor Perdue. Jimmy is a business man, who lives in Dodge County. He started his first business in 1974 and has been instrumental in establishing other businesses. Rep. Pruett is actively involved in industry recruitment for the local community and his efforts have been significant in bringing companies to his area of Georgia.

Rep. Pruett has served in many capacities including the Small Business Advisory Committee for the U.S. Senate and the Rural Economic Development Commission. Locally, he has served on the Advisory Board of the Heart of Georgia Technical School, Heart of Georgia Airport Authority, the Hospital Authority and the Board of Directors of Citizens Bank and Trust Company. His community and professional involvement includes serving on the Eastman-Dodge County Chamber of Commerce for 12 years, two years as vice-president of the Membership Committee and six years as a Chamber director.

He has been a member of the Conditioned Air Association of Georgia, the Eastman Dodge Historical Society and actively supports the American Cancer Society.
