Steven is now the CEO of Camden Connection, a not-for-profit agency where he has helped secure and manage more than \$1.5 million in project funds for community health and improvement projects. Steven has also served as a deputy sheriff for the Camden County Sheriff's Office until his start of office in the Georgia Legislature, where he had the pleasure of teaching the drug and crime prevention C.H.A.M.P.S. curriculum to elementary and middle school students.

Steven enjoys staying civically active, serving as planning commission chairman for the City of Woodbine, board member for the Camden County Chamber of Commerce and on the executive committee of the Woodbine Lions Club as the club secretary.
