

If a Georgia voter does not have a valid photo ID, a **Georgia Voter Identification Card** can be issued, free of charge, through the county registrar's office or the Department of Driver Services.

Voter identification is **not required** when voting by absentee ballot. However, a state ID or driver's license number is required when submitting an absentee ballot application **online**. For the purposes of identity confirmation, a **signature** is required on the absentee ballot for submission.
