HABERSHAM COUNTY: A Bill to change the corporate limits of the City of Demorest.

HB 613 by Representative Henson of the 86th

DeKALB COUNTY: A Bill to authorize DeKalb County to levy a hotel/motel tax.

HB 614 by SUBSTITUTE by Representative Jacobs of the 80th

DeKALB COUNTY: A Bill to provide for the creation of community improvement districts in the City of Brookhaven.

HB 616 by Representative Morris of the 156th

TOOMBS COUNTY: A Bill to provide a new charter for the City of Lyons.

HB 619 by SUBSTITUTE by Representative Oliver of the 82nd

DeKALB COUNTY: A Bill to change the corporate limits of the City of Chamblee and to provide for a referendum.

HB 620 by Representative Rice of the 95th

GWINNETT COUNTY: A Bill to authorize the City of Peachtree Corners to exercise all redevelopment powers as permitted under the State Constitution and the Redevelopment Powers Law pending a local referendum to approve the authorization.

QUITMAN COUNTY: A Bill to provide compensation for the members of the Quitman County Board of Education.

JACKSON COUNTY: A Bill to create the City of Commerce Public Facilities Authority and to provide for its powers and duties.

TERRELL COUNTY: A Bill to change the membership of the Dawson-Terrell County Airport Authority.

HB 625 by Representative Hitchens of the 161st

EFFINGHAM COUNTY: A Bill to change the corporate limits of the City of Rincon.

GREENE COUNTY: A Bill to amend the Act creating the Greene County Airport Authority so as to split the position of secretary-treasurer into two separate positions.

FULTON COUNTY: A Bill to amend the Act creating one or more community improvement districts in unincorporated Fulton County so as to change a certain provisions relating to the dissolution of the district.

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HB 628 by Representative Neal of the 2nd

CATOOSA, DADE, & WALKER COUNTIES: A Bill to amend the Act creating the Walker, Dade, and Catoosa Hospital Authority so as to change the method of filling vacancies on the hospital board.

COBB COUNTY: A Bill to provide a new charter for the City of Kennesaw.

HB 630 by Representative Kelley of the 16th

POLK COUNTY: A Bill to amend the Act creating the Polk County Board of Elections and Registration so as to provide for districts for the board members.

POLK COUNTY: A Bill to amend the Act creating the Polk County Water Authority so as to change provisions relating to the appointment, the taking of office, and the terms of office of members of the authority.

DOUGHERTY COUNTY: A Bill to amend the Act creating the Joint County-Municipal Board of Registration and Elections for Dougherty County and the City of Albany so as to provide for the appointment of board members.

DODGE COUNTY: A Bill to provide for membership on the Dodge County-Eastman Development Authority and to transfer the powers, duties, assets, property, liabilities, and indebtedness of the Heart of Georgia Regional Airport Authority to the Dodge County-Eastman Development Authority.

DODGE COUNTY: A Bill to abolish the Heart of Georgia Regional Airport Authority and to transfer its powers, duties, assets, property, liabilities, and indebtedness to the Dodge County-Eastman Development Authority.

HB 638 by Representative Ehrhart of the 36^h

COBB JUDICIAL CIRCUIT: A Bill to provide compensation for the judges of the Cobb Judicial Circuit.

HB 639 by Representative Mitchell of the 88th

STONE MOUNTAIN JUDICIAL CIRCUIT: A Bill to provide compensation for the judges of the Stone Mountain Judicial Circuit.

HB 641 by Representative Parsons of the 44th

COBB COUNTY: A Bill to provide compensation for the tax commissioner, the chief clerk in the tax commissioner's office, the executive secretary to the tax commissioner, and the administrative specialist in the office of the tax commissioner in Cobb County.

HB 642 by Representative Jacobs of the 80th

DeKALB COUNTY: A Bill to amend the charter of the City of Brookhaven so as to clarify provisions regarding the terms of office of the mayor, to provide for a finance director, to provide for the duties of such finance director, and to provide for a charter commission.
