

LOCAL LEGISLATION CALENDAR GEORGIA HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES

HB 661 by Representative Bentley of the 139th

TAYLOR COUNTY: A Bill to create the Taylor County Board of Elections and Registration and to provide for its powers and duties.

SB 254 by Senator Harper of the 7th

IRWIN COUNTY: A Bill to create the Irwin County Board of Elections and Registration and to provide for its powers and duties.

SB 256 by Senator Carter of the 1st

CHATHAM COUNTY: A Bill to provide that the chief magistrate of the Magistrate Court of Chatham County shall appoint any pro tempore magistrates.

SB 257 by Senator Mullis of the 53rd

CHATOOGA COUNTY: A Bill to amend the charter of the Town of Trion so as to provide for the continuation and support of the independent school system of the town and to provide limitations on the holding of other offices by the school superintendent and members of the board of education.

SB 258 by Senator Mullis of the 53rd

CHATOOGA COUNTY: A Bill to provide for a quorum and voting by the mayor and council of the Town of Trion.

SB 259 by Senator Mullis of the 53rd

CATOOSA & WALKER COUNTIES: A Bill to change the corporate limits of the City of Fort Oglethorpe.

HB 514 by SENATE COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE as AMENDED BY THE HOUSE

BIBB COUNTY: A Bill to amend the Act to provide a unified form of government for Macon/Bibb County so as to delete references to the City of Payne City, to change provisions relative to initial budgets, to provide for the first annual budget, to provide for the terms of certain boards, commissions, and authorities, to provide for transition of membership and appointing authority, to provide for membership on the transition task force, and to provide for a change in an effective date.

HB 583 by SENATE COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE by Representative Knight of the 130th

SPALDING COUNTY: A Bill to authorize the Municipal Court of the City of Griffin to charge a technology fee for each criminal and quasi-criminal fine paid.

HB 642 by SENATE COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE by Representative Jacobs of the 80th

DeKALB COUNTY: A Bill to amend the charter of the City of Brookhaven so as to clarify provisions regarding the terms of office of the mayor, to provide for a finance director, to provide for the duties of such finance director, and to provide for a charter commission.
