DEKALB COUNTY: A Bill to reapportion the DeKalb County Board of Education.

HB 1082 by Representative Jackson of the 128th

WASHINGTON COUNTY: A Bill to providing for a new charter for the City of Sandersville.

HB 1086 by Representative Black of the 174th

CAMDEN COUNTY: A Bill to create one or more community improvement districts in the City of Kingsland.

HB 1090 by Representative Greene of the 151st

CALHOUN & EARLY COUNTIES: A Bill to provide a new charter for the City of Arlington.

HB 1092 by Representative Yates of the 73rd

FAYETTE COUNTY: A Bill to amend an Act creating the Fayette County Public Facilities Authority.

HB 1097 by Representative Randall of the 142nd

BIBB COUNTY: A Bill to provide for the creation of one or more community improvement districts in Macon-Bibb County.

HB 1099 by Representative Jackson of the 128th

WARREN COUNTY: A Bill to provide that a member of the board of education of Warren County shall be authorized to serve simultaneously as deputy coroner of Warren County and that deputy coroner of Warren County shall be authorized to serve simultaneously on the board of the education of Warren County.

HB 1102 by Representative Broadrick of the 4th

WHITFIELD COUNTY: A Bill to authorize the City of Dalton to exercise all redevelopment powers as permitted under the State Constitution and the Redevelopment Powers Law pending a local referendum to approve the authorization.

HB 1103 by Representative Allison of the 8th

TOWNS COUNTY: A Bill to revise the terms of office and manner of election of mayor and council for the City of Young Harris.

HB 1104 by Representative Rogers of the 10th

HABERSHAM COUNTY: A Bill to amend an Act creating and establishing the State Court of Habersham County; to provide for terms of office for the judge and solicitor of said court; to provide for compensation.

HB 1105 by Representative Pruett of the 149th

TELFAIR COUNTY: A Bill to repeal the amendment to the Constitution of Georgia providing that county officers of Telfair County shall be ineligible to hold office under certain conditions.

HB 1106 by Representative Stephens of the 164th

BRYAN COUNTY: A Bill to create a Board of Elections and Registration for Bryan County, to provide for the powers and duties.

**PURSUANT TO ARTICLE VII, SECTION II, PARAGRAPH IV OF THE STATE
CONSTITUTION, THE FOLLOWING LOCAL BILLS RELATING TO HOMESTEAD
EXEMPTIONS REQUIRE A TWO-THIRDS ROLL-CALL VOTE FOR PASSAGE:**

HB 1093 by Representative Channell of the 120th

PUTNAM COUNTY: A Bill to provide a homestead exemption from City of Eatonton ad valorem taxes for municipal purposes in the amount of \$10,000 of the assessed value of the homestead for residents.

HB 1094 by Representative Channell of the 120th

PUTNAM COUNTY: A Bill to provide for a homestead exemption from City of Eatonton ad valorem taxes for municipal purposes in an amount equal to the amount by which the current year assessed value of a homestead exceeds the base year assessed value of such homestead for residents of that county who are 70 years of age or older.

HB 1095 by Representative Channell of the 120th

PUTNAM COUNTY: A Bill to provide for a homestead exemption from City of Eatonton ad valorem taxes for municipal purposes in an amount equal to the amount by which the current year assessed value of a homestead exceeds the base year assessed value of such homestead.
