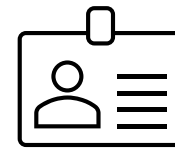
AT&T invested **nearly \$5 billion** in our wireless and wireline networks across the state from 2019- 2021.

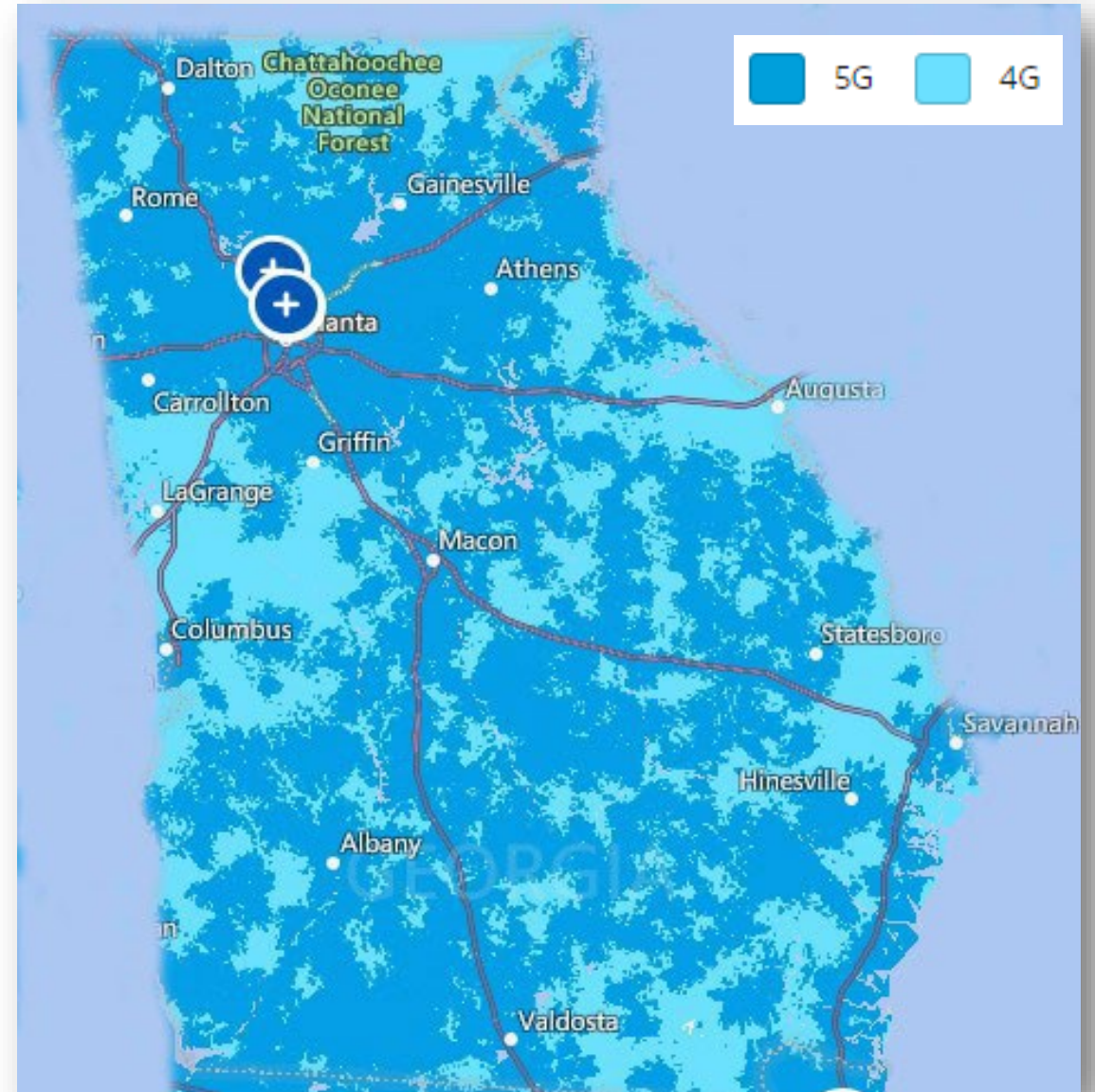
As America's **most reliable 5G network**, we know that connectivity relies on strong wireless networks.

100% of Georgia Covered With LTE



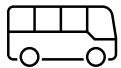
Meeting the Challenges of the Pandemic

The Demand on AT&T's Network



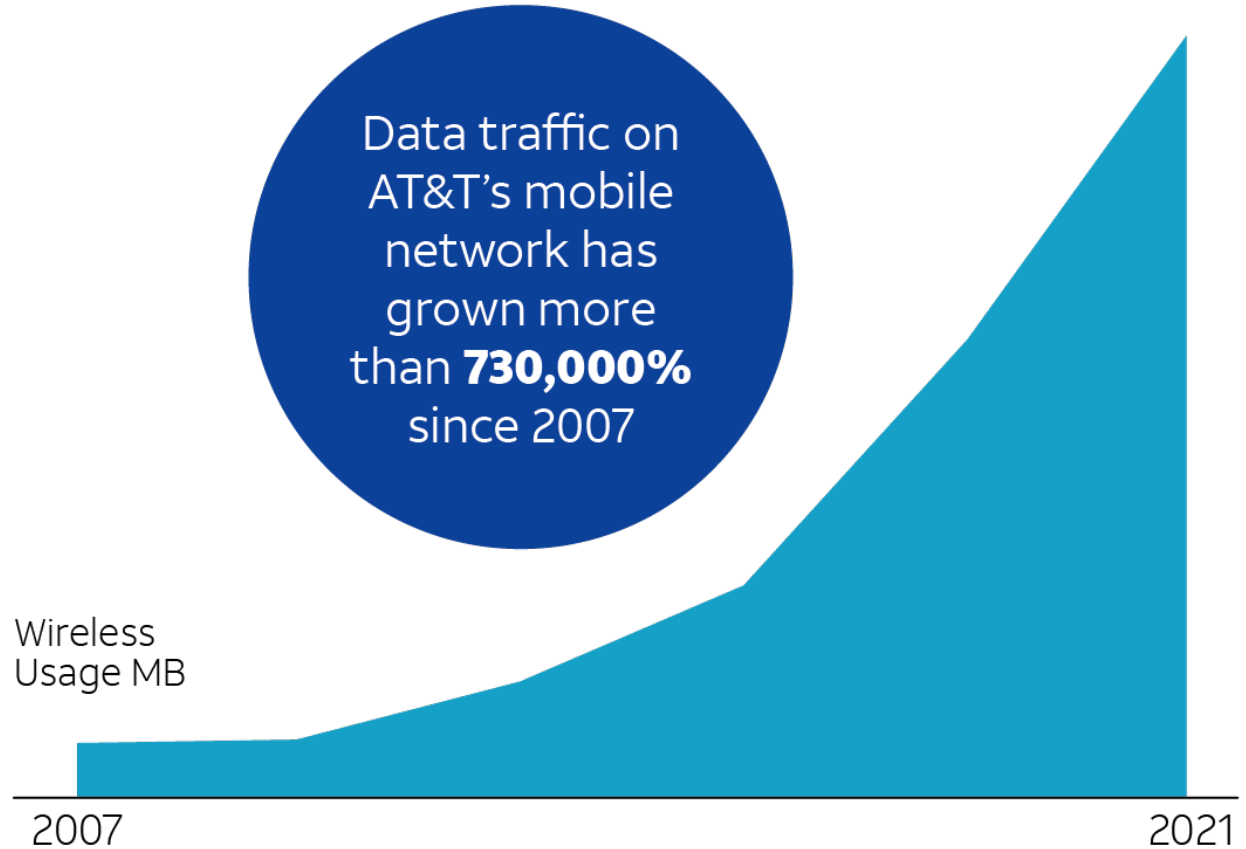
On an average day amid the pandemic, about **468 petabytes of data** crossed our network, up 40% year-over-year.

Addressing the Digital Divide



AT&T partnered with the Ga Dept of Education to deploy 448 wifi rangers in 36 school districts, filling the connectivity gap for thousands of students in rural school districts.

Affordable Connectivity Program (ACP)

Federal ACP benefit allows qualified households to lower their home internet or wireless costs by up to \$30 per month*, or by up to \$75 per month* if they are on qualified Tribal Lands.



Low-cost Internet

AT&T has introduced a new low-cost plan to its 'Access from AT&T' program* providing internet speeds of up to 100 MB for \$30 a month to eligible households. When combined with ACP, eligible households can reduce their monthly bill for home internet to \$0.
