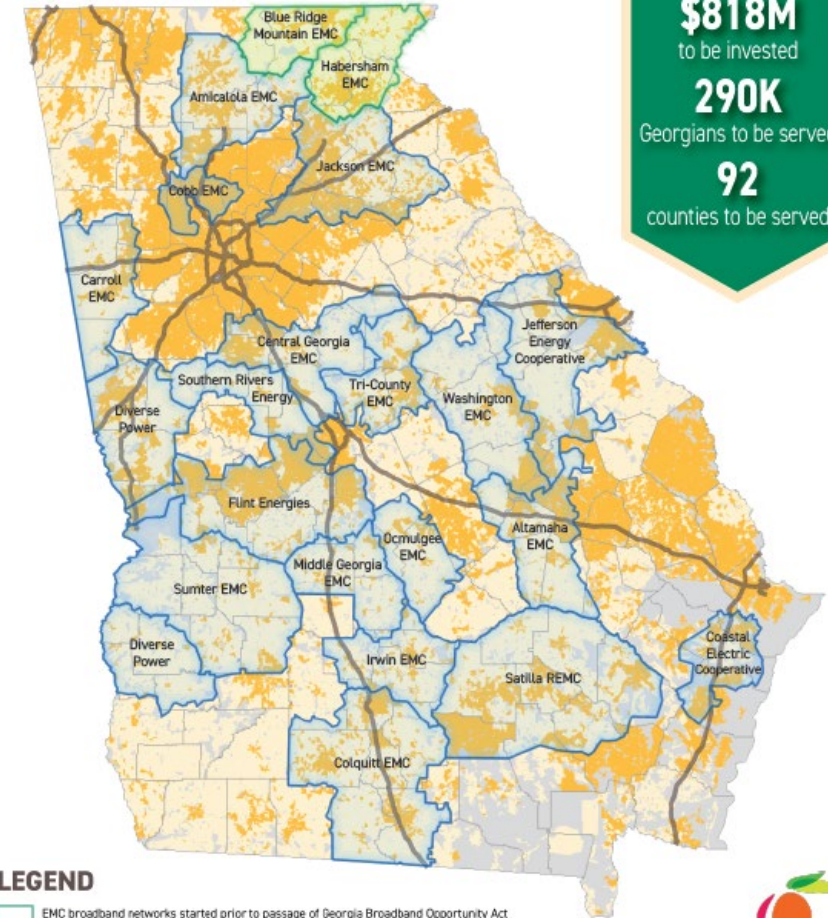

EMC Broadband: Connecting Georgians



- **EMC Broadband in GA at glance:**
 - 21 EMCs involved in broadband:
 - 6 – affiliate model
 - 15 – partnership or other arrangement
 - \$818M invested; 290K EMC members set to receive service
 - Majority of projects utilizing fiber to the home model
 - Additional announcements expected
- **Recent Funding Opportunities:**
 - *ARP State Fiscal Recovery Fund* – EMC involved projects receive \$130M of \$408M announced in Feb 2022 by Governor Kemp
 - *NTIA Middle Mile Broadband Infrastructure Program* - \$1B nationwide
 - *ARP Capital Projects Fund* - \$240M for GA
 - *NTIA Broadband, Equity, Access, and Deployment (BEAD) Program* - \$42.5B nationwide
