Dear Member of the General Assembly,

The Georgia General Assembly will resume the 2020 legislative session on Monday, June 15, the 30th Legislative Day.

House Resolution 1473 was adopted by both the House of Representatives and the Senate on March 12, 2020. The resolution provides

“that whenever, due to an emergency or disaster, resulting from manmade or natural causes or enemy attack, it becomes imprudent, inexpedient, or impossible to conduct the affairs of the General Assemblythe Speaker of the House of Representatives and the President of the Senate may, by joint agreement, order the discontinuation of the schedule for meetings provided by this resolution and provide for reconvening the House and the Senate at the State Capitol in Atlanta, Fulton County, on such date and at such time as they deem practical.”

Following such reconvening, the General Assembly may provide by joint resolution for a new schedule for meetings and adjournments.
