

PRESS CONFERENCE PROCEDURE

Press Conference Overview:

- House members may reserve various locations to hold a press conference at the Capitol.
- Press conferences may be held in room 610 of the Coverdell Legislative Office Building, or at the South Wing steps, Rotunda or the first floor space of the State Capitol.

Recording a Press Conference and Notifying the Media:

Press Conferences held in 610 CLOB:

- The Georgia House of Representatives operates its own video recording studio in room 610 CLOB.
- All requests to reserve 610 CLOB must be made through a representative's office.
- All press conferences/recordings must be held and conducted by members of the Georgia House of Representatives.
- The room may only be used for official House business, and all messages must be legislative or issue based.
- 610 CLOB may not be used to promote, disparage or endorse a political campaign, any candidate for political office, an elected official, constitutional officer or public official.
- Use of the recording studio is first come, first served and is only available during office hours, 610 CLOB cannot be reserved while the House is in session.
- The maximum occupancy for press conferences held in room 610 CLOB is 15.

Press Conferences held at the South Wing steps, Rotunda or the first floor space of the State Capitol.:

- These spaces are controlled by the Georgia Building Authority (GBA).
- GBA designates three locations for press conferences:
 - o (1) First Floor press conference space during regular hours of operation
 - o (2) South Wing (steps), during regular hours of operation based on its limited availability
 - o (3) Rotunda, for use only from 12:30 p.m. to 1:00 p.m. daily.

- To reserve one of these locations for a press conference during the legislative session, representatives should contact the House Media Services Office who will then work with GBA to schedule use of a location during an available time.
